











Pietro Moretti Il complice, 2024 oil, watercolour, marble dust on canvas 200 × 140 cm





Pietro Moretti Torpore, 2024 oil, watercolor, marble dust on canvas 183 × 152 cm













Pietro Moretti Lacci, 2024 watercolour on paper 32 × 24 cm







Galleria Doris Ghetta

Contemporary art and cultural heritage are key elements in building a solid and sustainable network of relationships between community and territory and in contributing to a more aware world.

Galleria Doris Ghetta is a contemporary art gallery based in Gherdëina/Val Gardena Italy, in the heart of Dolomites UNESCO World Heritage. In close connection with the Ladin language minority and its culture, Galleria Doris Ghetta promotes the flourishing of contemporary art, the development of critical thinking and the education in art and culture through residencies and interchange between local artists and the most contemporary international art research.

Founded in 2014 by Doris Ghetta in an industrial 400sqm exhibition space in Ortisei, in 2022 the gallery welcomed a young and dedicated partner, Eleonora Castagna, and opened a second venue in Milan. This marks a new orientation for the gallery.

Three central themes of contemporary discourse form the pillar for the exploration of a long-term programme: the role of a community and its development in the landscape; the habitat with its organic and inorganic inhabitants; an imaginary that is constantly evolving and shaping both the individual and society.

The gallery has also launched a new project space called Garasc, dedicated to talented and emerging artists who are encouraged to experiment and engage with the art gallery ecosystem through the production of site-specific work.

Through the gallery activities and Biennale Gherdeina, a contemporary art festival in the Dolomites founded by Doris Ghetta in 2008, Gherdeina/Val Gardena becomes a place where artists and people connect with nature and culture to create through art a new, sustainable future.

Artefiera 2024 Pietro Moretti

The paintings of Pietro Moretti interweave narratives in an atmosphere between the everyday and the fantastical. Drawing upon the imaginary of fairy tales and fables, Moretti's work reflects upon the ambivalence of emotions in intimate relations and the complexities of desire and identity in contemporay masculinities. In his works there is a focus on the body as an intersection between the personal and the social, often exploring the relationship with illness in Western societies. Through a dialogue between figuration and the non-figurative, Moretti's paintings emphasise the disjointedness and akwardness of painterly representation to question the unreliability of narratives and the porosity between psychological and physical realities.
